Almighty God, you search us and know us: may we rely on you in strength and rest on you in weakness, now and in all our days; through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Genesis 18: 16-33

The LORD appeared to Abraham by the oaks of Mamre

¹⁶ Then the men set out from there, and they looked towards Sodom; and Abraham went with them to set them on their way. ¹⁷The Lord said, 'Shall I hide from Abraham what I am about to do, ¹⁸ seeing that Abraham shall become a great and mighty nation, and all the nations of the earth shall be blessed in him? ¹⁹ No, for I have chosen him, that he may charge his children and his household after him to keep the way of the Lord by doing righteousness and justice; so that the Lord may bring about for Abraham what he has promised him.'

The Lord said 'How great is the outcry against Sodom and Gomorrah and how very grave their sin! ²¹ I must go down and see whether they have done altogether according to the outcry that has come to me; and if not, I will know.'

- ²² So the men turned from there, and went towards Sodom, while Abraham remained standing before the LORD.
- ²³ Then Abraham came near and said,

'Will you indeed sweep away the righteous with the wicked? ²⁴ Suppose there are fifty righteous within the city; will you then sweep away the place and not forgive it for the fifty righteous who are in it? ²⁵ Far be it from you to do such a thing, to slay the righteous with the wicked, so that the righteous fare as the wicked! Far be that from you! Shall not the Judge of all the earth do what is just?'

²⁶ And the LORD said, 'If I find at Sodom fifty righteous in the city, I will forgive the whole place for their sake.'

²⁷ Abraham answered, 'Let me take it upon myself to speak to the Lord, I who am but dust and ashes. ²⁸ Suppose five of the fifty righteous are lacking? Will you destroy the whole city for lack of five?'

And he said, 'I will not destroy it if I find forty-five there.'

²⁹ Again Abraham spoke to the Lord, 'Suppose forty are found there.'

He answered, 'For the sake of forty I will not do it.'

- ³⁰ Then Abraham said, 'Oh do not let the Lord be angry if I speak. Suppose thirty are found there.' The Lord answered, 'I will not do it, if I find thirty there.'
- ³¹ Abraham said, 'Let me take it upon myself to speak to the Lord. Suppose twenty are found there.'

The Lord answered, 'For the sake of twenty I will not destroy it.'

³² Then he said, 'Oh do not let the Lord be angry if I speak just once more. Suppose ten are found there.'

The Lord answered, 'For the sake of ten I will not destroy it.' ³³And the Lord went his way, when he had finished speaking to Abraham; and Abraham returned to his place.
